## ACE Entry Filers May File Post Summary Corrections in ACE Starting June 4, 2011; Post Entry Amendments to be Phased Out For ACE Filers



U.S. Customs & Border Protection (CBP) announced that it will deploy enhanced Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) capabilities effective June 4, 2011, to allow for Post Summary Corrections (PSC) for entry summaries filed in ACE. PSCs may be submitted for existing ACE entry types 01 and 03 entry summaries. As a result of this new capability, the PSC process will replace Post Entry Amendments (PEA) for entry summaries filed in ACE. Accordingly, hard copy PEAs will no longer be accepted for entry summaries filed in ACE, effective 90 days from the June 4, 2011, PSC effective date.

Importers that file their entries in ACE should discuss with their brokers the procedures they will follow when entry corrections are required, particularly in situations where entries are filed utilizing the broker's ACE account, rather than an ACE account assigned to the importer.
